A native New Yorker, Mr. Sloame attended Ramaz and Horace Mann School, and is a graduate of Columbia University's College and Law School. He also has a Masters in Law from Brooklyn Law School. He served in the Reagan Administration as HUD Deputy General Counsel and Deputy Assistant Secretary for Community Planning and Development.

Mr. Sloame was a Vice President and member of the Board of the American Jewish Committee's Washington chapter, where he founded and chaired the Energy Task Force for ten years and the International Relations Committee for four years. He was also the Vice Chairman of the Israel Project, and has practiced law in New York and Washington, DC.
